Proposal: As illustrated in the attached sketch, the trees requested to be removed are: A - Ash (TPO 1471 T1) B - Conifer C - Laurel D - Laurel.
A feature of the trees' location is that their bases are 2.5m above the ground level of the property at the top of an unretained and unstable bank. The current situation is undesirable as: 1. The ash is tall and rather close to the house. Branches that were hitting the gutter have previously been cut back. 2. The proximity of the ash will be even more of an issue with the building of 5/2018/2323. 3. The location at the top of the bank means that stability of the ash and conifer trees are substantially compromised due to limited root depth. 4. The bank is unstable and preferred remedial work is not possible due to risk of root damage. 5. The canopies of the ash and conifer are too high to provide any screening with the neighbouring property, 10 Harpenden Rd. This is a significant privacy issue at present. 6. The height of the ash and conifer present shading issues (particularly for 10 Harpenden Rd.) The request is to remove each of the four trees. Following this, work will be undertaken to: 1. Stabilize the bank with a combination of gabion and reinforced concrete walls 2. Add a new boundary fence with new Prunus Lusitanica hedging beside it 3. Plant one Prunus Pandora, Cherry (girth 20 - 25), one Sorbus Aucuparia, Rowan (girth 20 - 25) 4. Plant a significant quantity of other large shrubs/small trees as part of a wider garden design At the time of issueing TPO 1471, Andrew Branch of SADC advised it was not to protect the tree because of its quality but to ensure that the entire hedge was not removed without consultation.

Proposal: Front Garden: Area A1 (T1 on plan): Oak Tree Oak tree to have the 2 limbs towards the house shortened back to the epicormic growth. Remaining limbs to be shortened to shape & balance. There is no centre to the tree, leaving it an ungainly shape, with a vast amount of deadwood. Shortening the two limbs closest to the house would elevate any possible branch failure to a high cluster area of epicormic growth allowing the tree to regenerate the remaining canopy to be shaped and balanced. Rear Garden: T27 (T2 on plan) - Oak tree to be reduced by approx. 30%. This tree has not been worked on previously i believe; it is blocking out an abundance of light to the adjacent vegetable plot. A reduction to suitable lateral growth points would leave the tree with an amenity value yet containing the size for its location. Non-TPO (T3on plan) - Sycamore in the Rose Garden to be reduced by approx. 30%. This tree is very large to be in a small rose garden again blocking out a lot of light. A reduction would allow us to keep the tree and help improve the vitality of the rose garden. We are not sure if the Sycamore has a TPO as we can't see it on the original TPO document, but wanted to double check Gardener Contact: Izik.

Proposal: TREE SURGERY WORKS.

Cut back Zelkova tree to clear building by 2m.

End weight reduction varying between 1.5m & 6m affecting 1 Willow & 2 Horse Chestnut. Reasons: Road clearance & to reduce failure risk.

Crown reduction by up to 6m or where specified 20-30% affecting 2 Willow & 4 Oak.

Reasons: To reduce wind loading and risk of limb failure.

Reduce faulted limbs affecting lower limb of Horse Chestnut reduction by 6m.

Reasons: To reduce wind loading and risk of limb failure.

Crown lifting affecting 1 Horse Chestnut to be lifted to 3.5m over ground level.

TREE FELLING WORK.

Felling work affecting 4 Limes, 2 Willows, 1 Birch, 5 Cherry, 2 Horse Chestnut, 5 Sycamore, 1 Rowan, 1 Monkey Puzzle, 1 Evergreen Oak, 2 Sweet Chestnut, 1 Ash, 1 Larch, 1 Field Maple, 1 Goat Willow & 1 Oak.

Reasons: Varying between Structural defect, declining health, decay, bacterial Canker, poor physiological condition, open cavities, competition from adjacent trees & major deadwood.
