INTRODUCE AN ACCESS PERMIT CONCESSION FOR ELIGIBLE RESIDENTS FOR USE IN COUNCIL RUN CAR PARKS

THE ST ALBANS CITY AND DISTRICT COUNCIL (OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES) (AMENDMENT No. **) ORDER 202*

Proposal

It is proposed to make this Order to introduce a new permit to enable eligible residents born before 1954 to obtain a permit that allows them to park in any Council owned/run car park for up to 3 hours.

Statement of Reasons for Making the Order

The Council's Parking Strategy outlines our aims to deliver an efficient service that provides fair and safe parking across the district, to help shape, manage, and deliver the Council's vision for parking.

The new Access Permit is designed to offer a concession for older residents who regularly use our car parks and meet the eligibility criteria to purchase a permit to make it easier to park without having to go through the process of purchasing parking time from a pay and display machine or parking app when they use a car park.

The Order also makes minor modifications to the wording of certain Articles for clarity but does not make any changes to the restrictions or controls in the car parks which remain unchanged.
