## ST. ALBANS CITY AND DISTRICT COUNCIL

THE ST ALBANS CITY AND DSITRICT COUNCIL (CONTROL OF PARKING) ORDER 2023 (AMENDMENT No.7) ZONE VW, THIRLESTANE ORDER 2025 PROPOSAL FOR RESIDENTS PARKING PLACES, DESIGNATED DISABLED PARKING PLACES AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING RESTRICTIONS

St Albans City and District Council (pursuant to arrangement made with Hertfordshire County Council) proposes to introduce The St Albans City and District Council (Control of Parking) Order 2023 (Amendment No.7) Zone VW, Thirlestane Order 2025, under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended).

The general effect of the Order would be to introduce residents parking places with designated disabled parking places and restriction of waiting restrictions in:

## (a) St Albans, Bernards Heath - Thirlestane

It is intended that these measures will:

- Increase the available provision of residents parking places.
- Reduce instances of inappropriate or inconsiderate parking.
- Improve access to adjacent properties.
- Reduce congestion.
- Improve road safety.

The proposals have been developed following a consultation with Residents, District Councillors, Hertfordshire County Council, Hertfordshire Constabulary, and all other statutory consultees, taking into account Section 122 of Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
