## NOTICE OF MAKING AN ORDER PUBLIC PATH STOPPING UP ORDER TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

St Albans City & District Council Public Footpath, Sandridge 29a (Sandringham School) Public Path Stopping Up Order 2021

The above Order was made on 28th January 2021 under Sections 257 of the Town and County Planning Act 1990. The effect of the Order will be to stop up the full width of that part of Public Footpath, Sandridge No 29a commencing at the southern border of the footway of Sandringham Crescent at TL 1684 0957 (Point A) heading south southwest for approximately 10 metres to the northern boundary of Sandringham School at TL 1684 0956 (Point B). Continuing south south-west for approximately 95 metres to TL 1681 0947 (Point C) then east for approximately 200 metres to the eastern boundary of Sandringham School at TL 1701 0947 (Point D). Continuing east for approximately 5 metres to a junction with Sandridge Byway Open to All Traffic 3 at TL 1702 0947 (Point E) as shown on the Order Map.
