I have already objected to the application as a whole, but would like to comment on the amended plan showing the loss of the grass verge along the fence line.

There is a lamppost in the middle of the verge - where is this important source of light going?

Parallel parking along the fence line as proposed by Tarmac will reduce the driving area to one lane - how will cars safely manoeuvre if one is coming in and one going out? This is impractical and potentially very dangerous.

The pavement shown will be able to be driven over - again, potentially very dangerous especially during school pick-up and drop-offs. It would give children a false sense of security.

Entrance to the football club may require Parish Council spaces to be lost as the route shown is too tight. Any further loss of spaces exacerbates the issue of cars having to park out on the road which will cause visibility and safety issues - plus congestion along the High Street as it will effectively be reduced to one lane in places. It's already a problem during school pick-up and drop off times, and on match/event days.
